Information – When I first got my griddle (36" Blackstone) as a gift from my beautiful wife, I was a bit overwhelmed on about and variety of tool and gadget available. My value centered advice focuses on the 4 top things you need to get started for great griddling.

1. Basic griddle tools, 2 spatulas, scraper, and squeeze bottles. Normally these items come in a set.

- I do not like this one because the tools do not have holes in the handles, but for comparison, <u>Blackstone Version (\$19.97) at Walmart (you get extra bottle)</u>.
- Or the one I have, Walmart (\$9.88)

2. More bottles. I like having a bottle for water, oil, soy sauce, and sometimes hot sauce. Based on your need for bottles, you can get them super cheap at the Dollar Tree. Two clear condiment bottles for \$1. The Dollar Tree also has good deals on tongs and other utensils for, you guessed it, \$1.

3. Paper towels and trash bag – Critical items for operating and cleaning your griddle and tools. I am amazed how much trash I make when griddling. Paper towels help keep griddle and tools clean and neat. Always have a bunch on hand.

4. Half Sheet Trays – Literally the ideal vessel for holding a serving of your griddle creations. Two trays fit perfectly on my side shelves of the griddle, plus they are very cost effective. At <u>Walmart, a 10 pack is \$4.88, (less than \$0.50 per)</u>.
